Provenance

Our Alexander Kalterersee Classico Superiore is grown at an altitude of 350 metres, on the porphyry bedrock of a south-facing slope below the ruins of Leuchtenburg Castle – a unique location that, combined with the depth of the soil, allows us to produce an expressive Kalterersee with good shelf life.

Vinification and refinement

The grapes are hand-harvested and stored in the cellar in small containers. After de-stemming and fermentation in wooden and stainless steel tanks, they are then matured on fine yeast for 9 months. 80% of the wine mature in wooden vats, 20% in barriques. After 6 months of bottle ageing, Alexander is ready for sale.

Description

Alexander Kalterersee is fruity to the nose, with intense aromas of cherry and violet. With its elegant, soft tannins it offers an exquisite experience. It is a fresh, fruity and lighter red wine for all days.
